**Greetings from The Sparsha Trust Children and Team!!** 

We hope that you are all safe and fine. We feel that it is a good opportunity for all of us to stay home and give good time to our children and family members.

Sparsha Trust has also got impacted adversely by Covid 19 and the subsequent lockdown. Nearly 60-70% of our donors and individuals are facing many problems and in turn, this has affected us. All are struggling hard to safeguard themselves in one way or the other.

We do not want to disturb you all at the time of Corona pandemic and it is not right to ask anyone's support and we are not doing it.

We are happy to share with you all that we are all fine during the long 36 days of Corona lockdown. I, along with my family and with some admin team members, have moved to Nisarga Grama's children shelter and we are spending good quality time with children.

Now, out of 370 children to whom you were supporting, only 100 children and 20 staff are at the center as we had to reintegrate 270 children with their families for short term. It was very difficult to keep all the children and support them at this moment. The children who do not have anyone to take care of them, single parented children and children whose parents are staying far are only staying at Nisarga Grama.

We are engaging the children in the following activities (i) yoga and exercise (ii) cleaning the campus (iii) Big Boss











Activities where 6 groups have been formed, and each group has been assigned different responsibilities and tasks. These include cleaning the campus, museum development, classroom development etc. This is followed by story telling where we narrate stories from mythologies – Ramayana, moral lesson stories, general knowledge enrichment, prayer and singing of devotional songs.

A key activity is maintaining the greenery, plants and trees with campus made compost and eco-friendly techniques. We are also working on rain water harvesting and bore recharging activities, so that the rains of this year can be collected and made use of at a later stage.

Additionally, our children have given expression to their imagination by painting on the walls of Nisarga Grama. They are also gradually learning to do minor repairing or filling of cracks wherever they are found. This will help to seal seepage.

Each morning, the children are engaged in learning activities based upon the Class or standard they belong to. (English, computer, science, math and Hindi – basic concepts)

You all have supported us so far and you have made us to grow by encouraging us in all possible ways. We would like to retain this all the time and do the work of giving good citizens to our society. For this, you will have to stay with us, lead us by holding our hands and make us work in such a way that hundreds of children will be benefited from this organization.

We request you to help the needy people in your surroundings and provide at least one meal to them. we have to help others to control COVID-19. We also request you all to maintain social distance, use sanitizers and contribute to the welfare of our country by staying at home.

We know that you all will help the poor people, follow the rules and cooperate with the government and we hope that we will be successful in the battle against COVID-19.
