Sparsha Trust meetings was held on 13-03-2008 in order to constitute new board of Directors and as per the decision of the meeting new board of Director were elected on 17-06-2008

In the meeting held on 15-07-2008 the Board of director has taken the decision to adopt educational projects of the government to implement quality education and providing scholarship to poor and improving the learning levels of the slow learning, children through counseling in collaboration with other non-government organization and it was decided to provide at least 10 scholarships to the needy children and to improve the learning standards and positive thinking ability of slow learning children through educational workshop and counseling.

Sparsha Trust has organized a convention on 5th May, 2008 in which around 20 associations and organizations including schools and academic experts were participated deep discussions were held on the current issues and burning problems of educational field and several suggestions were made on the necessary reforms in education.



Many of the participants showed grave concern on the prompt implementation of the government programmers with regard to reaching the needy children. These are a great necessity of both private and government institution in understanding the need of the children through which the overall development can be achieved. In this situation, Sparsha Trust has to play its roles and responsibilities as a helping hand to the downtrodden children and to deliver a service to the cause of education.

Arivina Gari



A special program called Arivina Gari was held for three days between 27th, 28th and 29th of May 2008. The major focus on the "Significance of education in achieving the goal" which included the issue like deciding the goal, leadership qualities, personality development the rural development etc. this program was basically organized for the girl children of Baale Trust a residential children centre situated in Gopalpura near nelamangala. In this workshop Mr.K.C.Venkatesh an expert in Child Rights has conducted a day long session for the children. Mr.Jogihalli Ramu, singer and theater artist has made the children to sing and has explained the experience of rural life.

Fruitful camp for girl children.



An orientation camp was organized for three days from 18th to 20th of December 2008 for girl children of government school. Orientation on the issues like personality development, the role of the girl children in social development, the significance of education and such other relevant topics were held successfully. Education experts and social activist Mr.R.Gopinath conducted classes on "Personality Development". Mr.Jogihalli Ramu on the role of girl children in the society about 55 children was participated in the camp and learnt many things that they expressed.

Educational Excursion:

An education excursion was organized on 22-07-2008 about 35 children from the Government school were participated in the excision. The team was taken to visit Vidhanasoudha, Highcourt, cubban Park and many such other places in Bangalore. This train was able to meet the minister shared his views.
